- **Elementary Arabic 1** (ELA101)

Introduces Arabic letters and basic vocabulary of daily communication. Enables students understand, speak, write, read basic spoken Arabic, and gain an appreciation for Arabic cultures.

- **Elementary Arabic 2** (ELA102)

Continues to expose students to the four basic language skills. Students explore the cultural side of the Arab world through activities, presentations, and contact with native Arabic speakers and Arabic organizations.

- **Intermediate Arabic 1** (ELA103)

Focuses on improving students' oral skills and writing strategies in Arabic through project-based assignments. This course is mostly taught in Arabic.

- **Arabic for Heritage Speakers** (ELA105)

Designed to meet the needs of heritage speakers of Arabic in order to improve their literacy skills in Standard Arabic. Taught in Arabic.

- **Modern Arabic Literature in Arabic** (ELA201)

Examines an array of masterpieces from the late 19th century to the present. Literary genres include fiction, essays, poetry, and plays. Taught in Arabic.

- **Arabic Literature in English Translation** (ELA250)

Provides students with an opportunity to study Modern Arabic literature in translation and to become familiar with the cultures of the Middle East and North Africa. Taught in English.
